Background

Under current law, National Guard members who are called to active duty receive the same base pay and allowances that are paid to active duty military personnel of an equivalent rank and branch of service. However, National Guard members who are called to state active duty and who incur reimbursable travel expenses are reimbursed using the state employee reimbursement limits published in the uniform travel schedule. Expenses covered in the schedule include mileage, accommodations and meals. In certain cases, Wisconsin National Guard soldiers and airmen may be activated in state active duty and will serve with federal active duty military personnel, whose reimbursement is calculated under federal regulations.

Request

The department proposes changing the reimbursement limits for travel expenses for activated National Guard members to the federal schedules to ensure Wisconsin National Guard members are reimbursed at the same rate as the active duty military personnel with which they serve.

Fiscal Impact

Only in certain circumstances will this change result in a state fiscal impact. The federal government pays for the costs associated with training and deployments of the National Guard for national active duty. However, if the Governor orders the National Guard to state active duty, for example, to assist in a disaster, the costs are paid by the state. In these cases, the cost to the state for the activation may be higher if this change is implemented.

- **321.35 Pay and** Allowances. **(1)** Every officer and enlisted person on state active duty in the national guard shall receive the base pay-and allowances, and travel expenses of an officer or enlisted person of equal rank in the corresponding branch of the U.S. armed forces.
- (2) The governor may fix the pay of any member of the military staff of the governor, or other members of the national guard or state defense force for any special state active duty.
- (3) The governor may order, with the member's consent, to state active duty a member of his or her military staff who is a state employee. The assigned staff member shall receive the pay, but not the allowances, of an officer of equal grade in the U.S. armed forces.

members on state active duty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill allows a member of the national guard who is called into state active duty to receive the same amount of travel expenses as the federal government pays to an officer or enlisted member of equal rank in the corresponding branch of the U.S. armed forces. Currently, they are reimbursed the same amount of travel expenses as state employees.

For further information see the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 321.35 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

321.35 (1) Every officer and enlisted person on state active duty in the national guard shall receive the base pay and, allowances, and, notwithstanding ss. 16.53 (12)

- 1 (c) and 20.916 (8) and (9), travel expenses of an officer or enlisted person of equal rank
- 2 in the corresponding branch of the U.S. armed forces.
