



## 2013 SENATE BILL 178

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 29.194 (title), 29.194 (1) (b), 29.235 (5) and 29.563 (12) (a) 2.;  
2             *to repeal and recreate* 29.194 (1) (title); and *to create* 29.235 (3m), 29.563  
3             (4) (a) 2s., 29.563 (4) (b) 2s. and 29.563 (12) (a) 2m. of the statutes; **relating to:**  
4             hunting, fishing, and trapping approvals issued to recipients of the purple  
5             heart medal.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

6             **SECTION 1.** 29.194 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:  
7             **29.194 (title) ~~Approvals for students~~ Resident approvals for certain**  
8             **nonresidents and members of the armed forces, ~~reserves, or national~~**  
9             **guard.**  
10            **SECTION 2.** 29.194 (1) (title) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

**SENATE BILL 178****SECTION 2**

1           29.194 (1) (title) RESIDENT APPROVALS FOR CERTAIN NONRESIDENTS.

2           **SECTION 3.** 29.194 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

3           29.194 (1) (b) The department shall treat a qualified recipient of a purple heart  
4 medal, a qualified member of the armed forces, a qualified member of a reserve unit  
5 of the U.S. armed forces, or a qualified member of the national guard as a resident  
6 for purposes of determining the ~~member's~~ person's eligibility for and cost of obtaining  
7 a hunting, trapping, or fishing approval under this chapter, except for a conservation  
8 patron license issued under s. 29.235 (3m). A qualified recipient of a purple heart  
9 medal is a person who is not a resident who exhibits proof that he or she has received  
10 a purple heart medal. A qualified member of the armed forces is a person who  
11 exhibits proof that he or she is in active service in the U.S. armed forces or in forces  
12 incorporated in the U.S. armed forces and that he or she is stationed in this state.  
13 A qualified member of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed forces is a person who exhibits  
14 proof that he or she is a member of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed forces located in  
15 this state. A qualified member of the national guard is a person who exhibits proof  
16 that he or she is a member of the Wisconsin national guard.

17           **SECTION 4.** 29.235 (3m) of the statutes is created to read:

18           29.235 (3m) PURPLE HEART CONSERVATION PATRON LICENSE. The department shall  
19 issue a resident conservation patron license at the reduced fee under s. 29.563 (4) (a)  
20 2s. to any resident applying for this license who exhibits proof that he or she has  
21 received a purple heart medal. The department shall issue a nonresident  
22 conservation patron license at the reduced fee under s. 29.563 (4) (b) 2s. to any person  
23 applying for this license who is not a resident and who exhibits proof that he or she  
24 has received a purple heart medal.

25           **SECTION 5.** 29.235 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

**SENATE BILL 178**

1           29.235 (5) SUBSCRIPTION. At the time the department issues a conservation  
2 patron license, except for a license issued to a resident under sub. (3m), it shall  
3 provide each licensee who is at least 18 years of age with an annual subscription to  
4 the Wisconsin natural resources magazine without any additional fee or charge.

5           **SECTION 6.** 29.563 (4) (a) 2s. of the statutes is created to read:

6           29.563 (4) (a) 2s. Conservation patron issued under s. 29.235 (3m) to a recipient  
7 of the purple heart medal: \$9.25 or a greater amount at the applicant's option.

8           **SECTION 7.** 29.563 (4) (b) 2s. of the statutes is created to read:

9           29.563 (4) (b) 2s. Conservation patron issued under s. 29.235 (3m) to a recipient  
10 of the purple heart medal: \$160.25 or a greater amount at the applicant's option.

11           **SECTION 8.** 29.563 (12) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

12           29.563 (12) (a) 2. Archer, sports, or conservation patron, except as provided in  
13 subd. 2m: \$14.25 if deer tags are included; \$11.25 after open season and deer tags  
14 are not included.

15           **SECTION 9.** 29.563 (12) (a) 2m. of the statutes is created to read:

16           29.563 (12) (a) 2m. Conservation patron issued to a resident under s. 29.235  
17 (3m): \$2.50.
