



2013 SENATE BILL 335

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 20.445 (1) (d) and 106.05 of the statutes; **relating to:** an
2 apprenticeship completion award program, granting rule-making authority,
3 and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert
5 the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

1 **SECTION 2.** 20.445 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

2 20.445 (1) (d) *Apprenticeship completion award program.* The amounts in the
3 schedule for the apprenticeship completion award program under s. 106.05 (2).

4 **SECTION 3.** 106.05 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **106.05 Apprenticeship completion award program. (1) DEFINITIONS.** In
6 this section:

7 (a) “Sponsor” does not include a state agency or local governmental unit.

8 (b) “Tuition costs” means any fee that is charged for an apprentice to participate
9 in related instruction under s. 106.01 (6).

10 **(2) APPRENTICESHIP COMPLETION AWARDS.** (a) The department shall administer
11 an apprenticeship completion award program as provided in this section to partially
12 reimburse tuition costs incurred by any of the following:

13 1. An apprentice who has successfully completed part or all of the requirements
14 of his or her apprenticeship program as provided in par. (b) 1. and 2. and who is
15 employed in the trade, occupation, or business in which he or she is being trained
16 under the apprenticeship program.

17 2. The sponsor of an apprentice described in subd. 1.

18 (b) Subject to par. (c) and sub. (3), from the appropriation under s. 20.445 (1)
19 (d), the department shall provide to an apprentice described in par. (a) 1. or the
20 apprentice’s sponsor a completion award equal to 25 percent of the cost of tuition
21 incurred by the apprentice or sponsor or \$1,000, whichever is less, as follows:

22 1. The department shall make the first payment of a completion award upon
23 the successful completion of the first year of the apprentice’s apprenticeship contract.
24 The amount of the first payment may not exceed \$250.

1 2. The department shall pay the remainder of a completion award upon the
2 successful completion of all requirements of the apprentice's apprenticeship
3 program.

4 (c) The total amount of a completion award that the department may pay to an
5 apprentice and his or her sponsor may not exceed 25 percent of the cost of tuition
6 incurred by the apprentice and sponsor or \$1,000, whichever is less.

7 **(3) LIMITATIONS ON AWARDS.** (a) If the amount of funds to be distributed under
8 sub. (2) exceeds the amount available under s. 20.445 (1) (d), the department may
9 reduce the reimbursement percentage or deny applications for completion awards
10 that would otherwise qualify under sub. (2). In that case, the department shall
11 determine the reimbursement percentage and eligibility on the basis of the dates on
12 which apprentices and sponsors become eligible for completion awards.

13 (b) The department may provide a completion award under sub. (2) to a person
14 who is delinquent in child support or maintenance payments or who owes past
15 support, medical expenses, or birth expenses, as established by appearance of the
16 person's name on the statewide support lien docket under s. 49.854 (2) (b), only if the
17 person provides the department with one of the following:

18 1. A repayment agreement that the person has entered into, that has been
19 accepted by the county child support agency under s. 59.53 (5), and that has been
20 kept current for the 6-month period immediately preceding the date of the
21 application for a completion award.

22 2. A statement that the person is not delinquent in child support or
23 maintenance payments and does not owe past support, medical expenses, or birth
24 expenses, signed by a representative or designee of the department of children and

1 families within 7 working days before the date of the application for a completion
2 award.

3 (4) RULES. The department shall promulgate rules to implement this section.

4 **SECTION 4m. Initial applicability.**

5 (1) APPRENTICESHIP COMPLETION AWARD PROGRAM. This act first applies to an
6 apprentice who successfully completes part or all of the requirements of his or her
7 apprenticeship program as provided in section 106.05 (2) (b) 1. or 2. of the statutes,
8 as created by this act, on the first day of the 3rd month beginning after the rules
9 promulgated under section 106.05 (4) of the statutes, as created by this act, take
10 effect.
