## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill establishes a grant program to promote career and technical education programs in school districts that operate high school grades. Under the bill, the Department of Public Instruction (department) must annually confer with the Department of Workforce Development and the Wisconsin Technical College System to identify industries and occupations that face workforce shortages or shortages of adequately trained, entry-level workers.

DWD's Division of Employment and Training's (DET) Director-Bureau of Workforce Information and Technical Support (BWITS) will provide the annual request for industries and occupation. DWD expects that costs will be absorbed within the division as it is work that DET already completes.
