

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


Robin-

1. The intent of this bill is to provide that anyone who purchases a license to hunt with a bow and arrow may also hunt with a crossbow.
2. At the time of purchase the hunting license application should have a question for the applicant to answer regarding what weapon is intended to be used, ie, Bow, Crossbow, or Both.
3. The hunting tag itself should be the document indicating the way the animal is killed.
4. The intent of number 6 is to make sure that if due to biological (low deer count, or disease, etc) or social (extremely high number of bow/crossbow hunters) that DNR places restrictions on the most recent weapon policy change. In this case if there were a low deer count and the DNR wanted to replenish the herd the agency would first have to limit crossbow use rather than bow and arrow.

Hope that helps answer your questions.

Craig:

I'm not sure that I understand this drafting request:

1. There is no "archery season" established in statutes. Do you mean that you want the statutes to provide that any season open to hunting with a bow and arrow is also open to hunting with a crossbow, provided a person is eligible (because of age or disability) to use a crossbow under current law?
2. You ask that a person be required to check a box at the time of purchase. Are you referring to the purchase of a hunting license? Do you mean a box to be checked on a license application? On the license itself? Or are you referring to a box on some other piece of paper?
3. Again, on what document must there be a box checked indicating the way an animal is killed?
4. With regard to item 6. below, I will, as you indicate, need more explanation. Are you saying that if DNR decides to make changes to the dates for an open season for hunting with a bow and arrow or crossbow, and the changes result in a shorter season, then instead of a shorter season DNR must first impose restrictions on the use of crossbows?

CROSSBOW MEETING
Thursday, Jan 3, 2013
Natural Resource Building

Meeting stated with introduction of those in attendance (attendance sheet attached)

Greg Kazmierski – NRB Member stated the intent of the meeting was to get the interested partners in the same location to discuss the concept and idea of a Wisconsin Crossbow Season. Realizing not everyone agrees on the issue but the focus was to determine the ideas that people do agree on. Greg opened the floor for anyone to share their ideas or thoughts on the topic.

Brent Gardner – NRA via Conference Call

Stated the NRA support all inclusive crossbow use on the national and state level.

John Cumming – Wisconsin Crossbow Federation

Stated WCF was a supporter of all inclusive crossbow use nationally and in Wisconsin. Indicated that 22 states currently allow crossbows and provided some statistics on crossbow use in Ohio.

Greg Prince – Wisconsin Bowhunters Association

Wis Bowhunter Association supports crossbow use and support crossbow use in Wisconsin with the lesser weapon legislation in 2012. Indicated that crossbows are a superior weapon and concerns with technology creep stating the current crossbow capabilities and specification is just the tip of the iceberg.

Shared statistics on crossbow use in Michigan indicated a higher harvest, success rate with no increase in hunter numbers.

Shared ideas on a separate crossbow season, indicating the need to start slow and allow DNR to collect data on harvest, safety, success rates.

Season opening with archery opener to Oct 15

Continuation of current lesser weapon structure

Continuation of over 65 and disable permit system

Separate license

Maximum harvest to 2 bucks for all licenses (crossbow, archery, firearm)

Tony Grabski – QDMA

Support change that increases hunter #s and opportunity.

Concern with a separate crossbow license allowing the harvest of 3 bucks

Joseph Koback – SCI

Represent opportunity to get more hunters in woods

Regulation simplification is important.

The entire group had general discussion on the crossbow season concept with several common themes:

Importance of tracking success rates, how it could be done and knowing the # of hunters using crossbows

Importance of tracking harvest, registration system tracking weapon used to harvest deer.

Keeping system simple and less confusing to hunters

Quality of hunt and Wisconsin hunting tradition

Concerns with harvest, specifically buck harvest and hunting during rut

Importance of getting information from other crossbow states but also having ability to track Wisconsin data and harvest

Importance of hunters supporting hunters and addressing the decline in hunter #s

At the end of the meeting Greg Kazmierski inquired about what areas to most in the room agree on. The following items were listed as potential common ground.

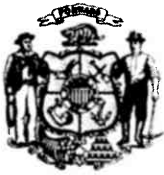
Support for crossbow season – full inclusion

Need to track harvest – registration system

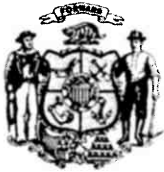

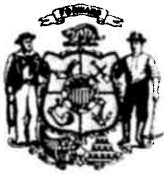

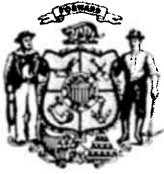
