Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a school board may not grant a high school diploma to any student unless the student has earned all of the following minimum credits in the high school grades: four credits of English; three credits of social studies; two credits of mathematics; two credits of science; and one and one-half credits of physical education. This substitute amendment increases the required credits in mathematics and science to three, and permits a school board to count towards one credit of mathematics a course in computer sciences. up to
