Citation procedure applicable to wetland discharge violations, sturgeon spearing license issuance period, electronic methods for reporting natural resource and environmental law violations, publication of class 1 notices, air dispersion modeling requirements, and membership on the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Council

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill, if enacted, would lower the age for a sturgeon spearing license; provide exceptions for testing air pollution under the federal Clean Air Act; and, allow the Department of Natural Resources to charge an applicant, who wishes to conduct an activity on navigable water, for the cost of publishing the class 1 notice.

Prosecutors do not anticipate any fiscal impact from this bill.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not anticipate any long-term fiscal effect on District Attorney offices if this bill is implemented.
