Can you turn the following into a Rush amendment for SB 314? I would need it by 11am tomorrow.

2. Amend (2)(b) to reference the new definition as follows:

(2) (b) If a project requires more than one approval or approvals from more than one political subdivision, the existing requirements applicable in each political subdivision at the time of filing the application for the first approval required for the project shall be applicable to all subsequent approvals required for the project, provided that the applicant identifies the full scope of the project at the time of the filing the application for the first approval.

3. Create a new exception making it clear that this bill does not preclude time limits on approvals.

(2)(d) Nothing in this section precludes a political subdivision from establishing expiration dates on approvals.

- 2 **1.** Page 2, line 10: after that line insert:
- 3 “(d) “Project” means a specific and identifiable land development that occurs
- 4 on specified ^{*defined and adjacent*} parcels of land ^{*which includes*} that are adjacent, including lands separated by ^{*roads, waterways*} a road,
- 5 ^{*roads, waterways and easements*} waterway, or easement.”
- 6 **2.** Page 2, line 19: delete “subdivision,” and substitute “subdivision and the
- 7 applicant identifies the full scope of the project at the time of filing the application
- 8 for the first approval required for the project.”
- 9 **3.** Page 3, line 11: after that line insert:
- 10 “(d) This section does not prohibit a political subdivision from establishing an
- 11 expiration date on an approval.”
