TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO SENATE BILL 179



September 6, 2013 - Offered by Senator ERPENBACH.

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

1. Page 2, line 6: delete the material beginning with "that line" and ending with page 3, line 9, and substitute:

"Section 1d. 66.01035 of the statutes is created to read:

66.01035 Ordinances affecting the rights and responsibilities of residential landlords and tenants. No city, village, town, or county may enact an ordinance that affects the rights or responsibilities of a residential landlord or tenant unless the ordinance is in conformity with state law or the ordinance preserves or promotes public health or safety.

SECTION 1m. 66.0104 of the statutes is repealed.".

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
