# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 SECTION 1. 23.33 (1) (gb) of the statutes is created to read:

6 23.33 (1) (gb) "Hazardous inhalant" means a substance that is ingested, 7 inhaled, or otherwise introduced into the human body in a manner that does not 8 comply with any cautionary labeling that is required for the substance under s. 9 100.37 or under federal law, or in a manner that is not intended by the manufacturer 10 of the substance, and that is intended to induce intoxication or elation, to stupefy the 11 central nervous system, or to change the human audio, visual, or mental processes.

21	of the substance, and that is intended to induce intoxication or elation, to stupefy the

2	or otherwise introduced into the human body in a manner that does not comply with
3	any cautionary labeling that is required for the substance under s. 100.37 or under
4	federal law, or in a manner that is not intended by the manufacturer of the substance,
5	and that is intended to induce intoxication or elation, to stupefy the central nervous
6	system, or to change the human audio, visual, or mental processes.
7	<b>SECTION 12.</b> 939.22 (42) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	939.22 (42) "Under the influence of an intoxicant" means that the actor's ability
9	to operate a vehicle or handle a firearm or airgun is materially impaired because of
10	his or her consumption of an alcohol beverage, <u>hazardous inhalant,</u> of a controlled
11	substance or controlled substance analog under ch. 961, of any combination of an
12	alcohol beverage, hazardous inhalant, controlled substance and controlled
13	substance analog, or of any other drug, or of an alcohol beverage and any other drug.
14	<b>SECTION 13.</b> 940.225 (5) (ai) of the statutes is amended to read:
15	940.225 (5) (ai) "Intoxicant" means any alcohol beverage, <u>hazardous inhalant</u> ,
16	controlled substance, controlled substance analog, or other drug, or any combination
17	thereof.
