2013 WISCONSIN ACT 90

AN ACT *to create* 66.1105 (6) (a) 12. and 66.1105 (6) (am) 2. g. of the statutes; **relating to:** lengthening the time during which tax increments may be allocated and expenditures for project costs may be made for Tax Incremental District Number 1 in the village of Wales.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.1105 (6) (a) 12. of the statutes is created to read:

66.1105 (6) (a) 12. Thirty–seven years after the tax incremental district is created if the district is Tax Incremental District Number 1 in the village of Wales.

SECTION 2. 66.1105 (6) (am) 2. g. of the statutes is created to read:

66.1105 (6) (am) 2. g. Expenditures for project costs for Tax Incremental District Number 1 in the village of Wales. Such expenditures may be made no later than 32 years after the district is created and may be made through 2038.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
