2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 282

1	AN ACT to amend $348.07(2)(g)$, $348.07(2)(gv)$ and $348.07(4)$; and to create
2	348.07 (2) (gr) of the statutes; relating to: the length of vehicles that may be
3	operated on the highway without an overlength permit.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4	SECTION 1. 348.07 (2) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:
5	348.07 (2) (g) 48 feet for a semitrailer or trailer operated as part of a 2-vehicle
6	combination, except as provided in par. <u>(gr) or</u> (gv).
7	SECTION 2. 348.07 (2) (gr) of the statutes is created to read:
8	348.07 (2) (gr) 53 feet for a semitrailer whose length from kingpin to axle does
9	not exceed 43 feet and which is operated as part of a 2-vehicle combination on a
10	highway designated under sub. (4). The length limits in this paragraph do not apply
11	to a trailer or a semitrailer that is authorized to operate under par. (im).

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1	SECTION 3. 348.07 (2) (gv) of the statutes is amended to read:
2	348.07 (2) (gv) 53 feet for a semitrailer whose length from kingpin to axle does
3	not exceed 43 feet and which is operated as part of a 2-vehicle combination, except
4	as provided in <u>par. (gr) or</u> sub. (4m). The length limits in this paragraph do not apply
5	to a trailer or a semitrailer that is authorized to operate under par. (im).
6	SECTION 4. 348.07 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	348.07 (4) The secretary shall, by rule, designate the highways to which sub.
8	(2) (f), (fm), and (gm), and (gr) and s. 348.08 (1) (e) apply. The designation of highways
9	under this subsection may not be inconsistent with the designation of highways
10	made by the U.S. secretary of transportation under P.L. 97-424, section 411. The
11	secretary may also designate additional highways by rule. In adopting a rule
12	designating other highways, which may include 2-lane highways, the secretary
13	shall specify the factors which resulted in the determination to designate the
14	highways. These factors shall include, but are not limited to, safety, economics,
15	energy savings, industry productivity and competition. Vehicles to which sub. (2) (f),
16	(fm), and (gm) <u>, and (gr)</u> and s. 348.08 (1) (e) apply may also operate on highways not
17	designated under this subsection for a distance of 15 miles or less in order to obtain
18	access to a highway designated under this subsection or to reach fuel, food,
19	maintenance, repair, rest, staging, terminal or vehicle assembly facilities or points
20	of loading or unloading. The secretary may, by rule, designate an access route of more
21	than 15 miles from a highway designated under this subsection when the longer
22	route provides safer and better access to a location which is within the 15-mile limit.
23	Household goods carriers may operate between highways designated under this
24	subsection and points of loading and unloading.

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SECTION 5. Initial applicability.
