2 1. Page 1, line 3: delete "on a contingent fee basis". ✓

3 2. Page 2, line 4: delete the material beginning with "If the" and ending with
4 "shall be" on line 6 and substitute "The contract shall be subject to s. 20.9305, shall
5 be ✓

6 3. Page 2, line 8: after that line insert: ✓

7 "SECTION 1m. 16.705 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 16.705 (1) The department or its agents may contract for services which can
9 be performed more economically or efficiently by such contract. The department
10 shall, by rule, prescribe uniform procedures for determining whether services are
11 appropriate for contracting under this subsection. If the services are legal services,
12 the contract is subject to s. 20.9305.

1 SECTION 1t. 20.930 of the statutes is amended to read:

2 20.930 Attorney fees. Except as provided in ss. 5.05 (2m) (c) 7., 46.27 (7g) (h),
3 49.496 (3) (f), and 49.682 (6), no state agency in the executive branch may employ any
4 attorney until such employment has been approved by the governor and any contract
5 for legal services is subject to s. 20.9305.
