2013 SENATE BILL 294

1 AN ACT *to amend* 972.15 (4m) of the statutes; **relating to:** access to presentence 2 investigation report by an assistant attorney general.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	SECTION 1. 972.15 (4m) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	972.15 (4m) The district attorney and, the defendant's attorney, and, following
5	a conviction for a felony in which an assistant attorney general has original
6	jurisdiction, served at the request of a district attorney under s. 978.05 (8) (b), or
7	served as a special prosecutor under s. 978.045, the assistant attorney general are
8	entitled to have and keep a copy of the presentence investigation report. If the
9	defendant is not represented by counsel, the defendant is entitled to view the
10	presentence investigation report but may not keep a copy of the report. A district

attorney or, the defendant's attorney, or an assistant attorney general who receives
a copy of the report shall keep it confidential. A defendant who views the contents
of a presentence investigation report shall keep the information in the report
confidential.
