1 AN ACT to amend 972.15 (4m) of the statutes; relating to: access to presentence

investigation report by an assistant attorney general.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides access to a presentence investigation report to the district attorney and to the defendant's attorney. This bill provides access to the report to the assistant attorney general following a conviction for a felony in which the assistant attorney general has original jurisdiction.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 972.15 (4m) of the statutes is amended to read:

972.15 (4m) The district attorney and, the defendant's attorney, and, following a conviction for a felony in which an assistant attorney general has original

jurisdiction, the assistant attorney general are entitled to have and keep a copy of

the presentence investigation report. If the defendant is not represented by counsel,

the defendant is entitled to view the presentence investigation report but may not

L	keep a copy of the report. A district attorney or, the defendant's attorney, or an
2	assistant attorney general who receives a copy of the report shall keep it confidential.
3	A defendant who views the contents of a presentence investigation report shall keep
