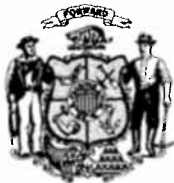

1 AN ACT *to amend* 972.15 (4m) of the statutes; **relating to:** access to presentence
2 investigation report by an assistant attorney general (suggested as remedial
3 legislation by the Department of Justice)

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill is explained in the NOTES provided by the Joint Legislative Council in the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

LAW REVISION COMMITTEE PREFATORY NOTE: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the Department of Justice and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes minor substantive changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable as a matter of public policy.

4 SECTION 1. 972.15 (4m) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 972.15 (4m) The district attorney and, the defendant's attorney, and, following
6 a conviction for a felony in which an assistant attorney general has original

1 jurisdiction, the assistant attorney general are entitled to have and keep a copy of
2 the presentence investigation report. If the defendant is not represented by counsel,
3 the defendant is entitled to view the presentence investigation report but may not
4 keep a copy of the report. A district attorney ~~or~~ the defendant's attorney, or an
5 assistant attorney general who receives a copy of the report shall keep it confidential.
6 A defendant who views the contents of a presentence investigation report shall keep
7 the information in the report confidential.
