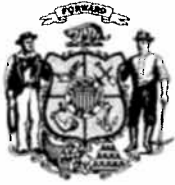

1 office of state employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association,
2 Inc., covering employees in the professional legal collective bargaining unit under
3 subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the
4 professional legal collective bargaining unit and approved and recommended by the
5 joint committee on employment relations, and authorizes the necessary expenditure
6 of moneys for implementation from the appropriations made by section 20.865 (1) of
7 the statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The director of the office
8 of state employment relations shall file an official copy of the agreement, certified by
9 the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment relations, with the
10 secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the parties that is not
11 a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.

SECTION 2. Effective date.

13 (1) This act takes effect on the day ^{after} following publication, except that those
14 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement
15 covering employees in the professional legal collective bargaining unit are effective
16 on the dates provided in that agreement.

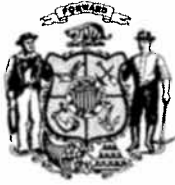
