**WAGE INCREASES IN 2013-2014 AGREEMENT**

**Professional Education (13) - WSEU**

**FISCAL YEAR INCREASES:**

A) FY14 General Wage Adjustment (GWA) equal to 1.0% of the base pay rate, limited by the pay range maximum, for each eligible employee in pay status on the first day of the pay period following the Agreement effective date, with a lump sum based on the GWA for hours in pay status back to June 30, 2013.

B) FY14 General Wage Adjustment for employees who received an increase of less than 1.0% effective June 30, 2013 due to the increase to the pay range minimum, equal to the difference between the increase the employee received and a full 1.0%, with a lump sum for hours in pay status back to June 30, 2013.
