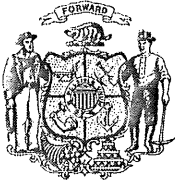

1 **AN ACT to create** 20.435 (5) (cd) and 46.535 of the statutes; **relating to:** grants
2 for crisis intervention team training and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services (DHS) to award grants for mental health crisis intervention team training for law enforcement agencies and correctional officers. The total amount of the moneys to be awarded as grants in each fiscal biennium is \$250,000 under the bill, and DHS pays those grants from general purpose revenue.

7 20.435 (5) (cd) *Crisis intervention training grants.* Biennially, the amounts in
8 the schedule for awarding grants for mental health crisis intervention team training
9 under s. 46.535.

10 **SECTION 3.** 46.535 of the statutes is created to read:

11 **46.535 Crisis intervention training grants.** From the appropriation under
12 s. 20.435 (5) (cd), the department shall award grants in the total amount of \$250,000
13 in each fiscal biennium for mental health crisis intervention team training for law
14 enforcement agencies, as described in s. 165.77 (1) (c), and correctional officers, as
15 defined in s. 102.475 (8) (a).
