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

Hi Tamara-

We are looking to do an amendment to AB 461. This can be a sub or simple, whatever you think is best.

- Eliminate the reference to "mild to moderate mental health care needs" (page 3, line 7) Could probably just say "mental health care needs"
- Eliminate the requirement for one urban and one rural regional program. (page 3, lines 13-14). Allow DHS to set hubs.
- Replace "on-site" requirement with "within state of Wisconsin" (page 4, line 4)
- Eliminate position requirements for the hub after "a. A psychiatrist..." (page 4 line 10. So please eliminate b,c,d (lines 13-15) and replace with giving DHS authority to decide.
- Eliminate specific reporting requirements and allow DHS to determine the requirements. (page 5 lines 22-25, page 6 lines 1-21)
- Eliminate the sunset provision of the funding mechanism.

Jon and Andrew,

Just so you know, we noticed an error in the analysis of the child psychiatry consultation program bill. It isn't substantive at all; an extra word ("care") was left in the first paragraph when we changed terminology in the draft.

Senator Darling's bill will have a corrected analysis removing this word. As soon as LRB-3212/2 is introduced, we will do a corrected copy of the Assembly bill analysis to remove the extra word. I just wanted to let you know that, until that time, the bills are identical but there will be one word different in the analyses. Neither of your offices need to take any action. We assumed this would be best in order to keep the version number the same while the draft is out for co-sponsorship.

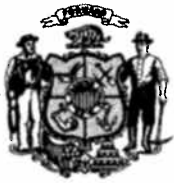

Hi Tamara-

We have a couple more changes that could probably just be rolled into the a1077/1.

- 1) Delete Page 7, lines 9-10. There is a concern that this DHS data collection provision is overly broad and could possibly extend data collection beyond the organizations that are recipients of the funding under the bill.
- 2) Modify Page 3, lines 7-9 & Page 4, lines 22-24. There is a concern by the insertion of the phrase "scope of primary care practice" into the statutes, as this could create future, unintended consequences. Therefore, the text could be modified: "to provide referral support for those pediatric patients who need care that is beyond the scope of primary care practice." This would also be updated on Page 4, lines 22-24.

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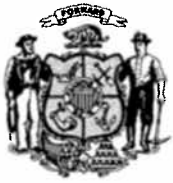
