



2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 704

January 31, 2014 – Introduced by Representatives VOS, KRAMER and RIPP, by request of Governor Scott Walker. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** state highway funding and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases funding for the Department of Transportation's state highway rehabilitation program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 9245. Fiscal changes; Transportation**

3 (1) STATE HIGHWAY REHABILITATION. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of
4 the statutes for the appropriation to the department of transportation under section
5 20.395 (3) (cq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2013, the dollar amount is
6 increased by \$43,025,700 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this
7 subsection takes effect to increase funding for the purposes for which the
8 appropriation is made.
