

Joe,

I would like to request the following amendments to SB 324. Please let me know if you need more information. We need these for floor session tomorrow. Thank you.

### Amendment 1

If the municipality has any polling locations that are not in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, then the clerk's office may offer in-person absentee voting hours without limitation to time or day.

### Amendment 2

If the municipality has a history of voters waiting in line to vote for one hour or more on Election Day at any polling location, either before or after the adoption of no-excuse in-person absentee voting, then the clerk's office may offer in-person absentee voting hours without limitation to time or day.

Amendment 3

If the municipality has a population of 10,000 or more, then the clerk's office may offer in-person absentee voting hours without limitation to time or day.

Amendment 4

Eliminate the cap on hours per week and also reinstate ability to schedule an appointment with the clerk outside of designated hours.
