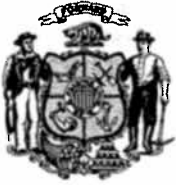

TO SENATE BILL 377

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Government Accountability Board (GAB) to prepare a report on each legislative proposal that impacts election law or the administration or conduct of elections in this state. GAB must prepare the report within 45 days after the proposal is introduced or offered in the legislature. The bill prohibits a legislative committee from holding a public hearing on the legislative proposal or from taking any vote on the legislative proposal until GAB has completed its report.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION ^{4m} 1. 13.0955 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **13.0955 Review of legislation affecting elections.** (1) DEFINITION. In this
5 section, "board" means the government accountability board.

6 (2) REPORT ON LEGISLATION AFFECTING ELECTIONS. (a) When legislation that
7 directly or substantially impacts election law or the administration or conduct of

1 elections in this state is offered or introduced in either house of the legislature, the
2 board shall prepare a report on the legislation within 45 days after it is offered or
3 introduced. The board shall confer with municipal clerks and boards of election
4 commissioners of both rural and urban municipalities and counties about
5 anticipated costs or savings associated with the proposed legislation and may
6 request any information from other state agencies, local units of government,
7 individuals, or organizations that is reasonably necessary for the board to prepare
8 the report.

9 (b) Legislation that requires a report under this section shall have that
10 requirement noted on its jacket when the jacket is prepared. When legislation that
11 requires a report under this section is offered or introduced, the legislative reference
12 bureau shall submit a copy of the legislation to the board.

13 (c) A report prepared under this section shall be printed as an appendix to the
14 legislation about which the report was prepared and shall be distributed in the same
15 manner as amendments.

16 (3) INFORMATION TO BE CONTAINED IN THE REPORT. The board shall include the
17 following information about the proposed legislation in its report:

18 (a) A discussion of how the legislation will affect the efficiency and effectiveness
19 of election administration.

20 (b) A discussion of whether the legislation is consistent with protecting and
21 enhancing the right of eligible electors to vote and to have a voice in their
22 government.

23 (c) A discussion of the anticipated costs or savings to local units of government,
24 the board, and the state as a result of implementing the proposed legislation.

BILL

1 (4) LEGISLATIVE ACTION ON PROPOSED LEGISLATION. No public hearing may be held
 2 before any standing committee on any legislation that requires a report under this
 3 section or, if no public hearing is to be held, no vote may be taken on the legislation
 4 by a standing committee until the board has completed its report and the report has
 5 been printed and distributed as provided under this section.
