At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

1. Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

"Section 1g. 5.05 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:

5.05 (5m) REPORT ON ELECTION FRAUDS, IRREGULARITIES, AND VIOLATIONS. The board shall annually report any information obtained under s. 7.15 (1) (g) to the appropriate standing committees of the legislature under s. 13.172 (3). The board shall include in the report required under this subsection recommendations to the legislature to address the suspected election frauds, irregularities, or violations identified in the report.".

- 2. Page 1, line 3: delete "Section 1" and substitute "Section 1r".
- **3.** Page 2, line 23: delete lines 23 and 24.
