**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 161**

January 6, 2014 – Offered by Senator GROTHMAN.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 813.025 (title); and *to create* 813.025 (3) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** injunctions suspending or restraining the enforcement or
3 execution of a statute of this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 813.025 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 **813.025 (title) Ex parte restraining orders; right of review of certain**
6 **orders.**

7 **SECTION 2.** 813.025 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

8 **813.025 (3)** If a circuit court or a court of appeals enters an injunction, a
9 restraining order, or any other final or interlocutory order suspending or restraining
10 the enforcement of any statute of this state, the injunction, restraining order, or other
11 final or interlocutory order is immediately appealable as a matter of right.
