



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 396**

January 21, 2014 – Offered by Senators GROTHMAN and LAZICH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 6, line 22: after “(b)” insert “An occupant of a retirement home may
4 vote in person at the polling place serving his or her residence or may apply for and
5 cast an absentee ballot at the election in the same manner as provided for other
6 electors of the municipality where he or she resides.”.

7 **2.** Page 7, line 3: delete the material beginning with “An” and ending with
8 “resides.” on line 6 and substitute “The municipal clerk or board of election
9 commissioners shall then provide the names and addresses to the special voting
10 deputies to verify which residents are eligible to cast their ballots with the special
11 voting deputies.”.

12 **3.** Page 12, line 3: delete the material beginning with “When” and ending with
13 “dispatched.” on line 5 and substitute “As soon as possible after visiting each”

1 residential care facility or retirement home, but not later than 18 hours after the
2 visit.”.

3 **4.** Page 12, line 8: delete the material beginning with “as expeditiously” and
4 ending with “day” on line 11 and substitute “ ~~, within such time as will permit delivery~~
5 ~~to the polling place serving the elector’s residence on election day. Personal delivery~~
6 ~~may be made by the deputies no later than noon on election day~~”.

7 **5.** Page 13, line 13: delete “at least 60 days”.

8 **6.** Page 13, line 14: after that line insert:

9 **“SECTION 21m. Effective date.**

10 (1) This act takes effect on May 1, 2014.”.
