Although your approach makes sense, in this case, I think it's best to just replace "certify" with "verify". When the amendment was discussed in the committee, there was a lot of discussion about replacing the word "certify" with "verify" and whether there was a difference between the two words. It seemed that eventually the consensus of the committee was that "verify" did not make a substantive change. The committee discussion led to a decision to stick with the use of "certify" in AA1.
