ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO SENATE BILL 267

February 14, 2014 – Offered by Representatives BERNIER and BORN.

| 1 | At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows: |
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| 2 | 1. Page 2, line 9: on page 1, line 4, of the material inserted by senate |
| 3 | amendment 2, after " <u>document,</u> " insert " <u>the last 4 digits of</u> ". |
| 4 | 2. Page 2, line 10: after "form" insert ". If the number on the identifying |
| 5 | document submitted by the elector has 6 or fewer digits, the clerk shall enter only |
| 6 | the last 2 digits of that number". |
| 7 | 3. Page 2, line 14: on page 1, line 7, of the material inserted by senate |
| 8 | amendment 2, after " <u>document,</u> " insert " <u>the last 4 digits of</u> ". |
| 9 | 4. Page 2, line 14: delete " <u>and</u> " and substitute " <u>. If the number on the</u> |
| 10 | identifying document submitted by the elector has 6 or fewer digits, the clerk shall |
| 11 | enter only the last 2 digits of that number. The municipal clerk or clerk's agent under |
| 12 | <u>s. 6.33 (5) (b)</u> ". |

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5. Page 3, line 2: after that line, delete the material inserted by senate
amendment 2 and substitute:

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"SECTION 2d. 6.33 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 6.33 (1) The board shall prescribe the format, size, and shape of registration $\mathbf{5}$ forms. All forms shall be printed on cards and each item of information shall be of 6 uniform font size, as prescribed by the board. The municipal clerk shall supply 7 sufficient forms to meet voter registration needs. The forms shall be designed to 8 obtain from each applicant information as to name; date; residence location; location 9 of previous residence immediately before moving to current residence location; 10 citizenship; date of birth; age; the number of a current and valid operator's license 11 issued to the elector under ch. 343 or the last 4 digits of the elector's social security 12account number; whether the applicant has resided within the ward or election 13district for at least 28 consecutive days; whether the applicant has been convicted of 14a felony for which he or she has not been pardoned, and if so, whether the applicant is incarcerated, or on parole, probation, or extended supervision; whether the 1516 applicant is disqualified on any other ground from voting; and whether the applicant 17is currently registered to vote at any other location. The form shall include a space 18 for the applicant's signature. Below the space for the signature, the form shall state "Falsification of information on this form is punishable under Wisconsin law as a 19 20Class I felony.". The form shall include a space to enter the name of any special 21registration deputy under s. 6.26 or 6.55 (6) or inspector, municipal clerk, or deputy 22clerk under s. 6.55 (2) who obtains the form and a space for the deputy, inspector, clerk, or deputy clerk to sign his or her name, affirming that the deputy, inspector, 23 $\mathbf{24}$ clerk, or deputy clerk has accepted the form. The form shall include a space for entry

of the ward and aldermanic district, if any, where the elector resides and any other 1 $\mathbf{2}$ information required to determine the offices and referenda for which the elector is 3 certified to vote. The form shall also include a space where the clerk may record an 4 indication of whether the form is received by mail, a space where the clerk may shall 5 record an indication of the type of identifying document submitted by the elector as 6 proof of residence under s. 6.34, whenever required, and the name of the entity or 7 institution that issued the identifying document, and, if the identifying document 8 includes a number that applies only to the individual holding that document, that 9 number. The form shall also include a space where the clerk, for any applicant who 10 possesses a valid voting identification card issued to the person under s. 6.47 (3), may 11 record the identification serial number appearing on the voting identification card. Each county clerk shall obtain sufficient registration forms for completion by an 12 13elector who desires to register to vote at the office of the county clerk under s. 6.28 14 (4).

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SECTION 2f. 6.33 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

16 6.33(2) (a) All information may be recorded by any person, except that the ward 17and aldermanic district, if any, other geographic information under sub. (1), the 18 indication of whether the registration is received by mail, the type of identifying 19 document submitted by the elector as proof of residence under s. 6.34, whenever 20 required, and any information relating to an applicant's voting identification card 21shall be recorded by the clerk. Each applicant shall sign his or her own name unless 22the applicant is unable to sign his or her name due to physical disability. In such case, 23the applicant may authorize another elector to sign the form on his or her behalf. If $\mathbf{24}$ the applicant so authorizes, the elector signing the form shall attest to a statement

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1 that the application is made upon request and by authorization of a named elector $\mathbf{2}$ who is unable to sign the form due to physical disability. 3 **SECTION 2h.** 6.34 (2) of the statutes is amended to read: 4 6.34 (2) Upon completion of a registration form prescribed under s. 6.33, each eligible elector who is required to register under s. 6.27, who is not a military elector 5 6 or an overseas elector, and who registers after the close of registration under s. 6.29 7 or 6.86 (3) (a) 2., shall provide an identifying document that establishes proof of 8 residence under sub. (3). Each eligible elector who is required to register under s. 9 6.27, who is not a military elector or an overseas elector, who registers by mail, and 10 who has not voted in an election in this state shall, if voting in person, provide an identifying document that establishes proof of residence under sub. (3) or, if voting 11 12by absentee ballot, provide a copy of an identifying document that establishes proof 13of residence under sub. (3). If the elector registered by mail, the identifying document may not be a residential lease.". 14**6.** Page 3, line 16: before "an" insert "and". 157. Page 3, line 18: on page 3, line 11, of the material inserted by senate 16 17amendment 2, delete that line and substitute "included a number that applies only 18 to the individual holding that document, up to the last 4 digits of that number.
