



2013 SENATE BILL 631

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 230.12 (10) (title); and *to create* 230.12 (10) (d) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** base pay paid to a former district attorney appointed to an
3 assistant district attorney position.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 230.12 (10) (title) of the statutes, as affected by 2013 Wisconsin Act
5 20, is amended to read:

6 230.12 (10) (title) DEPUTY AND ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY PAY PROGRESSION
7 PLAN; CALCULATION OF BASE PAY FOR CERTAIN ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS.

8 **SECTION 2.** 230.12 (10) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

9 230.12 (10) (d) Beginning on the effective date of this paragraph [LRB
10 inserts date], if a district attorney separates from that position and within 5 years

SECTION 2

1 is appointed to an assistant district attorney position, the person shall receive credit
2 for his or her years of service as a district attorney and any years of service as an
3 assistant district attorney, if applicable, for purposes of calculating his or her new
4 base pay as an assistant district attorney.
