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

"A school board shall allow a student enrolled in a home-based private educational program who has not met the minimum standards for admission to high school under 118.145 to take up to two courses at a public high school in the district if the school board determines the student qualifies for admission to those courses and if the school board determines there is sufficient space in the classroom."

3 "SECTION 118.53 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 118.53 (2m) A school board shall allow a pupil enrolled in a home-based  
5 private educational program who has not met the minimum standards for admission  
6 into high school under s. 118.145 (1) to attend up to 2 courses at a public school in  
7 the district during each school semester if the school board determines that the pupil  
8 qualifies for admission to those courses and if there is sufficient space in the  
9 classroom."
