2013 WISCONSIN ACT 215

AN ACT *to create* 125.09 (7) of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting municipalities from providing alcohol beverages retailers with identification scanners.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.09 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

125.09 (7) MUNICIPALITY PROVIDING IDENTIFICATION SCANNERS. No municipality may provide, to any retail licensee under this chapter, any device capable of scanning an official identification card, as defined in s. 125.085 (1) (a) and (b).

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
