



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 799**

March 20, 2014 – Offered by Representative VRUWINK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: delete “pedestrians crossing”.

3 **2.** Page 1, line 4: delete “tracks” and substitute “crossings”.

4 **3.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

5 “SECTION 1g. 192.292 of the statutes is amended to read:

6 **192.292 Trains obstructing highways.** It shall be unlawful to stop any
7 railroad train, locomotive, or car upon or across any highway ~~or~~, street, or private
8 road crossing, outside of cities, or leave the same standing upon such a highway or
9 street crossing longer than 10 minutes or upon a private road crossing longer than
10 20 minutes, except in cases of accident; and any railroad company that shall violate
11 this section shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$500 or any officer of such
12 company responsible for the violation shall be liable to imprisonment of not more
13 than 15 days.”.
