



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 727**

February 13, 2014 – Offered by Representatives RICHARDS, KESSLER, JORGENSEN,
HEBL, HESSELBEIN, BARNES, BEWLEY, GENRICH, KOLSTE, PASCH and ZEPNICK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 7: delete “injunction and” and substitute “injunction.”

3 **2.** Page 1, line 8: after “firearm” insert “, providing information to a firearms
4 dealer when purchasing a handgun, authorizing the Department of Justice to
5 prosecute violations of certain laws regulating firearms, and providing penalties”.

6 **3.** Page 4, line 7: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 3c.** 175.35 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 175.35 (3) (a) and
8 amended to read:

9 175.35 (3) (a) Any person who intentionally violates sub. (2), ~~(2e)~~, (2f), or (2j)
10 shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$10,000 and may be imprisoned for
11 not more than 9 months.
