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

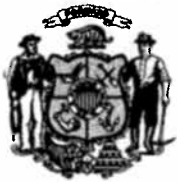

**TO ASSEMBLY BILL 741**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: after "Council" insert "; funding for well-woman program and  
3 maternal home visits; and making an appropriation".

4 **2.** Page 2, line 12: after that line insert:

1       **25.76 BadgerCare Plus restoration fund.** There is established a separate  
2 nonlapsible trust fund designated as the BadgerCare Plus restoration fund  
3 consisting of all moneys transferred from the general fund to the BadgerCare Plus  
4 restoration fund.

5       **SECTION 4.** 49.45 (23p) of the statutes is created to read:

6       **49.45 (28p) BADGERCARE PLUS RESTORATION PROGRAM.** The department shall  
7 create a program to provide outreach services to individuals who lost eligibility for  
8 the BadgerCare Plus program and to provide payment for claims that would have  
9 been paid by the BadgerCare Plus program had the individual not lost eligibility for  
10 the program. An individual shall make a claim within one year of losing eligibility  
11 for BadgerCare Plus to be eligible for reimbursement under this program.

12       **SECTION 5.** 79.15 of the statutes is amended to read:

13       **79.15 Improvements credit.** The total amount paid each year to  
14 municipalities from the appropriation account under s. 20.835 (3) (b) for the  
15 payments under s. 79.10 (5m) is \$75,000,000 in 2009, \$145,000,000 in 2010, and  
16 \$150,000,000 in each year beginning in 2011 and ending in 2014, and \$600,000,000  
17 in 2015 and in each year thereafter.
