Hello Tracy,

I was wondering if you could put together an additional preliminary amendment for LRB 0119 – AB 120. I appreciate the other one you did but I want to have two for the Representative to use as a comparison before deciding what course of action to take.

For this one we would want to draw a line at the filing of the action, stating that all qualifying statements made before a suit is filed are inadmissible. For the draft, I think it would look something like this:

(2) A statement, gesture, or the conduct of a health care provider, or a health care provider's employee or agent, that expresses apology, benevolence, compassion, condolence, fault, liability, remorse, responsibility, or sympathy to a patient or to his or her relative or representative, <u>made prior to the commencement of a medical professional liability action</u>, <u>liability action</u>, <u>administrative action</u>, <u>mediation or arbitration</u>, is not admissible into evidence or subject to discovery in any civil action or administrative hearing regarding the health care provider as evidence of liability or as an admission against interest.

My only question for you is would this allow a lawyer to ask, did you make a statement saying, "I apologize for....". Would we need to keep the subject to discovery portion that I highlighted in red above in in order to cover that scenario?

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 120

3/24/13 Today or by Tuesday

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- 1. Page 2, line 8: delete lines 8 to 13 and substitute:
- "(2) A statement, a gesture, or the conduct of a health care provider, or a health care provider's employee or agent, that satisfies all of the following is not admissible into evidence in any civil action, administrative hearing, disciplinary proceeding, mediation, or arbitration regarding the health care provider as evidence of liability or as an admission against interest:
- (a) The statement, gesture, or conduct is made or occurs before the commencement of the civil action, administrative hearing, disciplinary proceeding, mediation, or arbitration.

1 (b) The statement, gesture, or conduct expresses apology, benevolence,
2 compassion, condolence, fault, liability, remorse, responsibility, or sympathy to a
3 patient or his or her relative or representative.".
