

Hi Cory,

I entered this amendment as LRBa1290 for AB-388. When I have something in a form that meets your approval, I can draft a companion for SB-307.

I need a little clarification on the first part of this (below). Under the bill, for certain offenses DOT orders the offender to attend a safe driver course. DOT then cannot reinstate the offender's license until the offender completes the course. Which of the following is your intent:

1. That DOT will still order the offender to take the safe driver course, but completion of the course in NOT a requirement for reinstatement of the license
OR
2. DOT will NOT order the offender to take a safe driver course (and of course the course is not required for reinstatement).

[Traffic school/safety courses ordered by DOT or the courts under current law would not be affected by the above change.]

For your other question, the bill is already the way you want it – license suspension for “great bodily harm” or death but not for ordinary bodily harm.

Aaron,

We'd like to have an amendment drafted to AB 388/SB 307 that would eliminate the requirements added under this bill that an individual would need to take a class to have their license reinstated. Where current law already requires a class (OWI, failure to yield) please keep that intact.

In short, where we added a class is necessary for reinstatement, please take it out.

We want to keep the Drivers Ed instruction in the bill.

Finally, just to clarify...with regards to Bodily harm, is that just a double of fines? Or do we have it so that bodily harm is also a means for license suspension? I don't think we want bodily harm to be a means for suspension, but we do want that for Great Bodily Harm and death. Please let know how we have it.
