AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- 1. Page 5, line 15: after that line insert:
- "(f) 1. Notwithstanding par. (a), a town, village, or city may enact and enforce an ordinance establishing minimum standards for constructing, altering, or adding to public buildings or buildings that are places of employment that are stricter than the applicable rules under sub. (15) (j) if the town, village, or city submits a petition to the building code council for authorization to enact and enforce such an ordinance and the building code council approves the petition.
- 2. The building code council may approve a petition under subd. 1. only if the council finds that the ordinance is necessary to address a concern that is specific to that town, village, or city and that relates to health, safety, welfare, or economic development.".

- 2. Page 6, line 5: after "council." insert "The council shall also act on petitions
 submitted under s. 101.02 (7r) (f).".
