\*\*\*AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE\*\*\*

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 1. Page 5, line 15: after that line insert: ✓
- 3 “(f) 1. Notwithstanding par. (a), a town, village, or city may enact and enforce
- 4 an ordinance establishing minimum standards for constructing, altering, or adding
- 5 to public buildings or buildings that are places of employment that are stricter than
- 6 the applicable rules under sub. (15) (j) if the town, village, or city submits a petition
- 7 to the building code council for authorization to enact and enforce such an ordinance
- 8 and the building code council approves the petition.
- 9 2. The building code council may approve a petition under subd. 1. only if the
- 10 council finds that the ordinance is necessary to address a concern that is specific to
- 11 that town, village, or city and that relates to health, safety, welfare, or economic
- 12 development.”.
