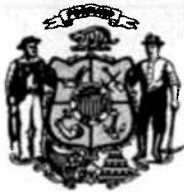

2013 SENATE BILL 339

October 14, 2013 - Introduced by Senator LEIBHAM, cosponsored by Representatives TITTL, BERNIER, KERKMAN, KNODL, LEMAHIEU, SPIROS and STONE. Referred to Committee on Workforce Development, Forestry, Mining, and Revenue.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 563.93 (2) of the statutes; **relating to:** the price of a Class A
2 raffle ticket.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, certain religious, charitable, service, fraternal, veteran's, or tax-exempt organizations may obtain a Class A or Class B raffle license. A Class A raffle license allows an organization to conduct raffles in which at least some tickets are sold on days other than the day of the drawing. A Class B raffle license allows an organization to conduct raffles in which all tickets are sold on the same day as the drawing. Current law limits the price of a Class A raffle ticket to \$100. This bill increases the limit on the price of a Class A raffle ticket to \$500.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 563.93 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 563.93 (2) No raffle ticket may exceed ~~\$100~~ \$500 in cost.

5 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**
