1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 440.62 (3) (ar) 2., 454.02 (3) (b), 454.06 (2) (b), 454.06 (3) (b),
2 454.06 (4) (b) 1., 454.06 (5) (b) 1., 454.06 (6) (b) 1., 454.10 (2), 454.23 (2) (d),
3 454.23 (3) (b) and 454.26 (2); and *to create* 454.02 (3) (bm), 454.075, 454.21 (3)
4 and 454.245 of the statutes; **relating to:** cosmetologist training hours,
5 recognition of accredited schools of barbering, cosmetology, aesthetics,
6 manicuring, and electrology, exemption of makeup artists from barbering and
7 cosmetology licensure requirements, and requiring the exercise of rule-making
8 authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

9 **SECTION 1.** 440.62 (3) (ar) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
10 440.62 (3) (ar) 2. Requires as a prerequisite to graduation completion of a
11 course of instruction in cosmetology of at least ~~1,800~~ 1,550 training hours in not less

1 than 10 months. The course of instruction may not exceed 8 training hours in any
2 one day for any student or 48 hours in any one week for any student.

3 **SECTION 2.** 454.02 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 454.02 (3) (b) ~~Applying cosmetics~~ A service performed preparatory to a live
5 public performance or appearance, whether in-person or through broadcast media,
6 including the Internet.

7 **SECTION 3.** 454.02 (3) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:

8 454.02 (3) (bm) A service performed in the course of the production of any
9 digital, analog, or other recording of a moving or still image intended for public
10 release or broadcast, including through the Internet.

11 **SECTION 4.** 454.06 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

12 454.06 (2) (b) Graduates from a course of instruction of at least ~~1,800~~ 1,550
13 training hours in not less than 10 months in a school of cosmetology licensed under
14 s. 440.62 (3) (ar) ~~or~~, exempted under s. 440.61, or accredited by an accrediting agency
15 approved by the board, or has successfully completed an apprenticeship under s.
16 454.10.

17 **SECTION 4c.** 454.06 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

18 454.06 (3) (b) Completes 4,000 hours of practice as a licensed cosmetologist
19 under the supervision of a licensed cosmetology manager or completes 2,000 hours
20 of practice as a licensed cosmetologist and 150 training hours of theoretical
21 instruction in a school of cosmetology licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ar) ~~or~~, exempted
22 under s. 440.61, or accredited by an accrediting agency approved by the board.

23 **SECTION 4g.** 454.06 (4) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

24 454.06 (4) (b) 1. A course of instruction in aesthetics of at least 450 training
25 hours in not less than 11 weeks and not more than 30 weeks, in a school of

1 cosmetology or a school of aesthetics licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ar) or (b) or,
2 exempted under s. 440.61, or accredited by an accrediting agency approved by the
3 board.

4 **SECTION 4n.** 454.06 (5) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

5 454.06 (5) (b) 1. A course of instruction in electrology of at least 450 training
6 hours in not less than 11 weeks and not more than 30 weeks, in a school of
7 cosmetology, or a school of electrology licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ar) or (c) or,
8 exempted under s. 440.61, or accredited by an accrediting agency approved by the
9 board.

10 **SECTION 4r.** 454.06 (6) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

11 454.06 (6) (b) 1. A course of instruction in manicuring of at least 300 training
12 hours in not less than 7 weeks and not more than 20 weeks, in a school of cosmetology
13 or a school of manicuring licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ar) or (d) or, exempted under
14 s. 440.61, or accredited by an accrediting agency approved by the board.

15 **SECTION 4t.** 454.075 of the statutes is created to read:

16 **454.075 Examining board approval of accrediting agencies.** The
17 examining board shall identify by rule the accrediting agencies it approves to
18 accredit schools for the purpose of satisfying educational requirements for an initial
19 license or a license renewal under this subchapter.

20 **SECTION 4w.** 454.10 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

21 454.10 (2) Apprentices shall receive at least 3,712 hours of practical training
22 and at least 288 training hours of theoretical instruction in a school of cosmetology
23 licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ar), exempted under s. 440.61, or accredited by an
24 accrediting agency approved by the board in order to complete the apprenticeship
25 program and be eligible to take the examination for a cosmetologist license.

1 Apprentices shall receive training for a total of at least 32 hours per week. The
2 training shall be completed in not less than 2 years and not more than 4 years.

3 **SECTION 5.** 454.21 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

4 454.21 (3) (a) A service performed preparatory to a live public performance or
5 appearance, whether in-person or through broadcast media, including the Internet.

6 (b) A service performed in the course of the production of any digital or analog
7 recording of a moving or still image intended for public release or broadcast,
8 including through the Internet.

9 **SECTION 5e.** 454.23 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 454.23 (2) (d) The applicant graduates from a course of instruction in barbering
11 of at least 1,000 training hours in barbering in not less than 10 months in a school
12 of barbering licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ag) or accredited by an accrediting agency
13 approved by the department, a school of cosmetology licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ar)
14 or accredited by an accrediting agency approved by the cosmetology examining
15 board, or a school that is exempted under s. 440.61 or the applicant successfully
16 completes an apprenticeship under s. 454.26.

17 **SECTION 5m.** 454.23 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

18 454.23 (3) (b) The person completes 4,000 hours of practice as a licensed barber
19 or licensed cosmetologist under the supervision of a licensed barbering manager or
20 licensed cosmetology manager or completes 2,000 hours of practice as a licensed
21 barber or licensed cosmetologist and 150 training hours of theoretical instruction in
22 barbering in a school of barbering licensed under s. 440.62 (3) (ag) or accredited by
23 an accrediting agency approved by the department, a school of cosmetology licensed
24 under s. 440.62 (3) (ar) or accredited by an accrediting agency approved by the
25 cosmetology examining board, or a school that is exempted under s. 440.61.
