



2013 SENATE BILL 269

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 218.11 (5m) and 218.43 (intro.) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 penalties for violation of certain moped dealer and recreational vehicle dealer
3 requirements and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 218.11 (5m) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 218.11 **(5m)** Any person who ~~shall violate~~ violates any provision of this section
6 ~~shall~~ may be required to forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for the first
7 offense and may be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each offense a 2nd
8 or subsequent conviction within 3 years.

9 **SECTION 2.** 218.43 (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 **218.43 Penalty.** (intro.) Any person violating s. 218.41 or a lawful rule or order
11 issued thereunder ~~shall, upon conviction,~~ may be subject to a fine of required to

1 forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for the first offense and may be fined not
2 less than \$25 and not ~~nor~~ more than \$100 for a 2nd or subsequent conviction within
3 3 years.

4 **SECTION 3. Initial applicability.**

5 (1) This act first applies to violations committed on the effective date of this
6 subsection, but does not preclude the counting of other violations as prior violations
7 for purposes of sentencing a person.
