Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits certain felony offenders from possessing, controlling, or residing with a vicious dog for a specified period of time. Prosecutors are uncertain how many felony offenders currently, or in the future, plan to possess, control, or reside with vicious dogs; consequently, it is difficult to estimate the potential cost to the District Attorney program should this bill be enacted.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Due to uncertainty about how many felony offenders plan to possess, control, or reside with vicious dogs, a long-range fiscal estimate of the cost to the District Attorney program, should this bill be enacted, is indeterminate.
