Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department to establish a child psychiatry consultation program. The Department must select and fund qualified organizations to provide the consultation services through regional hubs. The organizations must meet the criteria specified in the bill.

The bill provides a new biennial appropriation for operating the consultation program, equal to \$500,000 GPR per year. The bill repeals the appropriation at the end of FY 15, but appears to mandate that DHS fund the regional hubs on an ongoing basis.

The bill would increase costs for the Department. The Department would need to establish an application process and review applications from organizations to determine whether they meet the requirements in the bill. These requirements include staffing, hours of operation, service array, and telecommunication capabilities. Each year, organizations must report to the Department details about consultation services provided. The Department must conduct annual surveys of clinicians who use the consultation program. It must also conduct, at minimum on an annual basis, interviews of participating clinicians regarding barriers and benefits of participation and to determine the participating clinician's treatment abilities, confidence, and awareness of relevant resources before and after using the consultation program.

To perform these activities, the Department would need a 1.0 FTE human services program coordinatorsenior, at an annual cost of \$79,900 GPR and \$2,500 in one time costs.

It is assumed that the annual cost of funding the regional consultation hubs would equal the \$500,000 appropriated in the bill for FY 14 and FY 15. Therefore, the total fiscal effect of the bill would be \$579,900 GPR annually and \$2,500 in one time costs.
