Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill permits the Department of Workforce Development or a person who has been discriminated against on the basis of military service, to bring an action in circuit court to recover compensatory and punitive damages after the completion of all administrative proceedings before DWD and the Labor and Industry Review Commission.

Prosecutors do not believe that this bill, if enacted, will have more than a negligible fiscal effect on their offices.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

District Attorneys do not expect this bill, if enacted, to have a long-term fiscal impact on their offices.
