Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides that within 65 business days from the date on which the Department receives a complete application for approval of a proposed high capacity well, or for reconstruction or replacement of an existing high capacity well, it must approve or deny the application. The bill prohibits the Department from including conditions in an approval for a replacement high capacity well that are different than the conditions in the approval for the high capacity well being replaced. This bill also provides that if a person who owns property on which a high capacity well is located transfers the property, the owner may transfer the approval for the high capacity well to the person to whom the land is transferred without review by the Department and without having to pay a fee. The bill also provides that if, on or after July 6, 2011, new conditions were added to a previously approved high capacity well the department shall, upon the request of the owner, remove the new conditions from the approval.

Fiscal Effect--Annual Costs

The bill will increase costs to the Department by an estimated \$1,500 of salary and supplies-related expenditures associated with 0.02 FTE. This estimate of fiscal impact includes costs associated with responding to requests to remove new or more restrictive conditions added to high capacity well approvals issued after July 6, 2011.

The Department estimates that it will take 0.02 FTE of Water Supply Specialist Advanced time to review an estimated 10 requests to remove high capacity well conditions. The Department's time estimate assumes that each request will take approximately 3 hours to review and modify the approval as necessary.

- --10 reguests for modification of conditions x 3 hrs/ license = 30 hours
- --30 hrs./1800 hrs. per FTE = 0.02 FTE
- --Water Supply Specialist Adv. (\$32.84/hr. salary and fringe) x 2080 hrs. + \$5200 supplies related expenditures = \$73,500 x 0.02 FTE = \$1,500
