## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law requires the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) to appoint a wage council after an investigation reveals there is cause to believe an employee is not being paid a living wage. This bill creates a permanent wage council in DWD and requires the wage council to meet early in the regular session of the legislature and make recommendations to DWD regarding any rule changes that may be necessary to ensure that an employee is receiving a living wage. DWD may convene the wage council at other times during the regular session of the legislature if, upon investigation, DWD finds there is reasonable cause to believe an employee is not receiving a living wage. If DWD does convene the wage council, the wage council must study the need for an increase in the living wage and report its recommendations to DWD.

The DWD Equal Rights Division projects that providing staff support to a permanent wage council and promulgating new rules as specified in this bill would require approximately 400-500 work hours from current staff in the Equal Rights Division. The Equal Rights Division anciticpates it will be able to distribute this work load between current staff.

Based on the proposed number of council members, the Equal Rights Division projects annual meeting costs for the wage council will be \$5,000. The cost of publications and printing is estimated at \$5,000 annually also.

This bill also increases the minimum wage for employees generally, beginning January 1, 2015, from \$7.25 per hour to \$8.00 per hour, or an amount determined by DWD rule, whichever is greater.
