<b>Description</b> Claims for loss of society and companionship in medical malpractice cases		

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill provides that a parent has the right to recover for loss of society and companionship if the parent's adult child is injured as the result of medical malpractice. In addition, the bill provides that an adult child has the right to recover for loss of society and companionship if the adult child's parent dies as the result of medical malpractice.

Prosecutors do not anticipate any fiscal impact on their offices should this bill be enacted.

**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not expect there to be a long-term fiscal impact on their offices.
