**Assembly Bill 559**, relating to: special group plates for women veterans, vehicle title information provided to county registers of deeds, the issuance of more than one motor vehicles operator's license to a person, location of emissions inspection stations, and insurance registration for motor carriers operating in multiple jurisdictions (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Transportation),, withdrawn from Committee on **Transportation, Public Safety, and Veterans and Military Affairs** and rereferred to Committee on **Senate Organization**.
