

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 28 [2013 Assembly Bill 214]

Ex Parte Communications With the **Public Service Commission**

Under current law, certain people are not allowed to communicate about the merits of, or a threat or offer of reward related to, an ongoing contested case before the Public Service Commission (PSC) (*ex parte* communications) unless they do so in the context of the formal contested case process. This process generally affords all parties the opportunity to participate in any communications. There are certain exceptions to this prohibition.

2013 Wisconsin Act 28 adds an additional exception to this prohibition which allows these *ex parte* communications during a contested case before the PSC by or to any official or employee of the PSC other than the hearing examiner or a commissioner.

Initial Applicability: The Act first applies to *ex parte* communications made on the effective date of the Act.
