

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 110 [2013 Senate Bill 296] Transaction Information for Management of Enforcement System Report

The Department of Justice (DOJ) is required to administer the transaction information for the management of enforcement system to provide access to information concerning law enforcement. This system is commonly referred to as the TIME system.

Act 110 repeals a provision that was enacted in 1991 and required DOJ to submit to the Joint Committee on Finance a resource allocation plan that set limits and priorities for access to the TIME system if the average daily message volume for any three-month period exceeded 100,000.

Effective date: Act 110 took effect on December 15, 2013.
